

Marutani Fellowship

About the Honorable William M. Marutani



The Hon. William M. Marutani was a second-generation Japanese American who served six months in an American internment camp following the Pearl Harbor attack in 1942.

As an attorney, Judge Marutani participated in the civil rights drives in the South and helped organize the 1963 March on


Washington for the Japanese American Citizens League (JACL). In 1967, Judge Marutani appeared on argument before the United States Supreme Court in Loving v. Virginia, a seminal case which struck down anti-miscegenation laws in 17 states.

In 1975, Judge Marutani became the first Asian Pacific American judge in Pennsylvania and the first Asian Pacific American outside of the Pacific Coast to preside as a judge of a court of general jurisdiction. As a judge, he issued the decision requiring the all-boys Central High School to admit female students in 1983.

Up until his death in 2004, Judge Marutani served on numerous civic and charitable boards and commissions. Notably, in 1981 he was appointed by President Jimmy Carter to the Commission on Wartime Relocation and Internment of Civilians, which concluded that the internment of Japanese Americans was the unjust result of racism, wartime hysteria and a failure of political leadership.

The Marutani Fellowship

The Judge William M. Marutani Fellowship was established by APABA-PA in conjunction with the Philadelphia Bar Foundation. The Fellowship award provides a stipend for an Asian Pacific American law student taking a summer internship position with a public interest law organization or a government agency (including the judiciary) in Pennsylvania, in the hopes of giving Asian Pacific American law students a greater opportunity to gain employment in areas in which Asian Pacific American attorneys are currently underrepresented.

Fellowship Recipients



Guozhen Xigo

Guozhen Xiao is a third-vear J.D. student at Penn State Dickinson Law School, Before coming to the United States, Guozhen tauaht herself law and passed the Chinese bar exam in 1998. For 10 vears in Beijina, she served as a pro human riahts defending democracy activists and religious peoples in criminal while working as cases, the primary legal counsel for corporate clients, developing their internal systems of contract review. labor relations, and intellectual properties.

During her studies at Dickinson, Guozhen writes and translates American news and opinions, advocating for judicial justice and equal protection under the law. This summer, she served as a certified legal intern for the SeniorLAW Center (Philadelphia).

Guozhen is the single mother of two teenage daughters, who joined her from China, and who keep her on her toes. She says, "Life is generous to give me more than I dreamed."



Neeraja Aravindan

Neeraja is a New Jersey native and 2019 graduate of the College of William & Mary, where she graduated cum laude. While at William & Mary, Neeraja served as a President's Aide, director of the Orientation Program, and as a member of the Undergraduate Honor Council. Neeraja went on to work as a Research Editor at TED Conferences LLC.

As a 1L, Neeraja worked as a parttime clerk with Calderone Bullock LLC, a patent firm in New Jersey. In Summer 2022, she was a 1L LCLD Scholar and Summer Associate at Faegre Drinker in Philadelphia. As a 2L, Neeraja externed for U.S. District Court Judge Renee Marie Bumb in Camden, New Jersey.

This past summer, Neeraja was a Marutani Fellow and Pennsylvania Legal Aid Network Martin Luther King, Jr. intern for Community Legal Services, Inc. in Philadelphia, litigating debt collection defense for low-income Philadelphians. Neeraja is passionate about public service and providing high quality legal representation.



She has also served on the cabinet of the PBA, including as its Diversity Chair, Secretary and Assistant Secretary.

Sophia is a thought leader and frequent speaker on matters involving DEI and ESG and serves as an adjunct professor at Temple's Beasley School of Law teaching courses on DEI in the legal profession. She has been recognized by, among others, The Philadelphia Inquirer, the Philadelphia Business Journal and The Legal Intelligencer for her achievements.
